RV and Overnight Parking

Overnight parking on show grounds will be by reservation only. Reservations must be received by May 29. Parking is available from 3:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 3 and during the stated hours of the specialty show. No camper hook-ups available. No vehicles with dogs may be left unattended overnight. Overnight parking in designated areas only. Fire lanes must be maintained. No holding of space. Entering together is the only way of staying together. All trash must be placed inside CLEAN plastic bags and placed in barrels provided by the club. Bred By Exhibitor Class

The Bred by Exhibitor class shall be for dogs that are owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran classes are open to dogs and bitches seven (7) years of age and over. Winners of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Veteran Dogs, for dogs 7 years of age and over.

Veteran Bitches, for bitches 7 years of age and over.

Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog class*, where indicated, will be for stud dogs and two of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed (Variety) competition, or some other non-regular class.

Brood Bitch class* – Same as for the stud dog except substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provide that “a castrated male may be entered as stud dog in the stud dog class and a spayed bitch may be entered as brood bitch in the brood bitch class.”

Breed Prizes

Trophies are offered for first place in all regular dog and bitch classes.

The Colonial Shetland Sheepdog Club offers Winners Dog and Winners Bitch a sterling silver and enamel medallion with the logo of the American Shetland Sheepdog Association.

Annual Puppy Sweepstakes

For Shetland Sheepdog puppies 6 to 18 months old on the day of the show. Puppy sweepstakes entrants must also be entered in one of the regular conformation classes at this show. No AKC champions may be shown. Entry fees must accompany entry forms which may be submitted on the same form as the regular classes indicating "Puppy Sweepstakes" in the space for additional classes.

Puppy Dogs, 6 – 9 months	Junior Dogs, 12 – 18 months
Puppy Dogs, 9 – 12 months	(same classes for bitches)

The Puppy Sweepstakes at this show has a reduced entry fee of \$10.00. The judging of sweepstakes will be judged prior to the conformation classes.

The amount of money received from each separate sweepstakes fees will be divided as follows: 40% retained by the club for expenses, with 60% to be divided among the first, second, third and fourth place winners of the sweepstakes as follows:

Junior Showmanship Classes

AKC Junior Handlers numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Novice Junior class: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate class: For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior class. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior class. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Junior Showmanship class in a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate class: For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior class. This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 14 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Junior Showmanship class in a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Junior handlers who win a third Novice class after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice class to the Open class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular confirmation judging or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of the Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.
